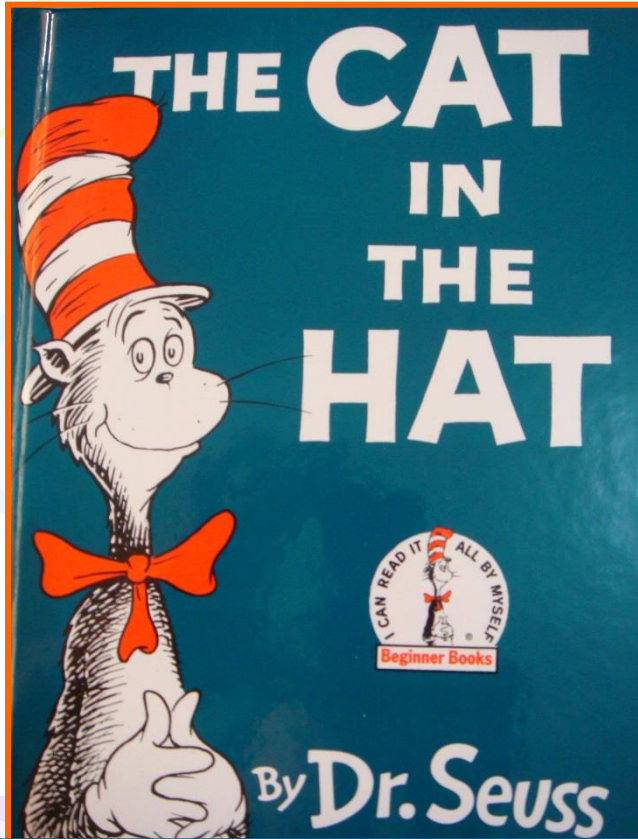

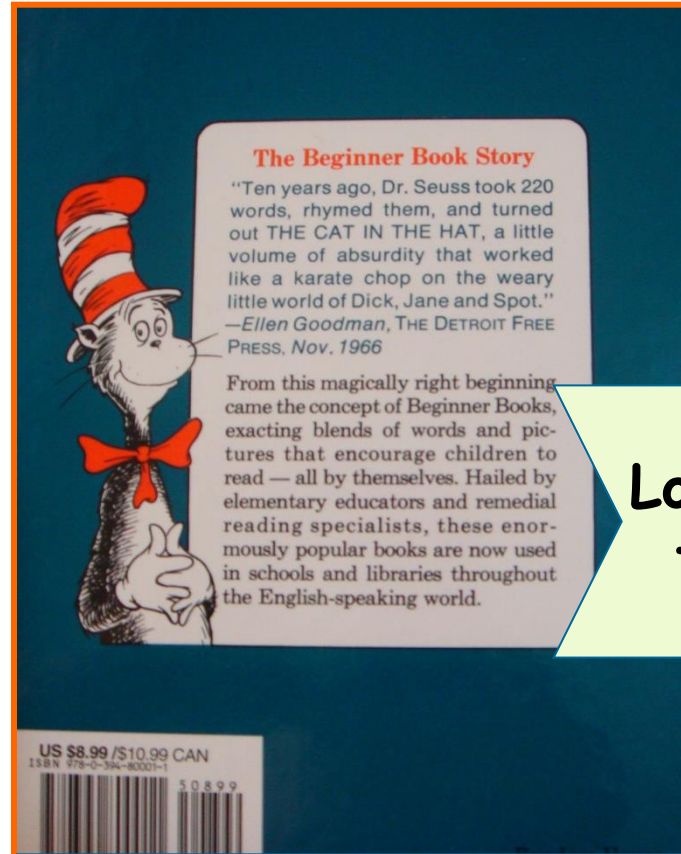

Pre-Reading: Preview



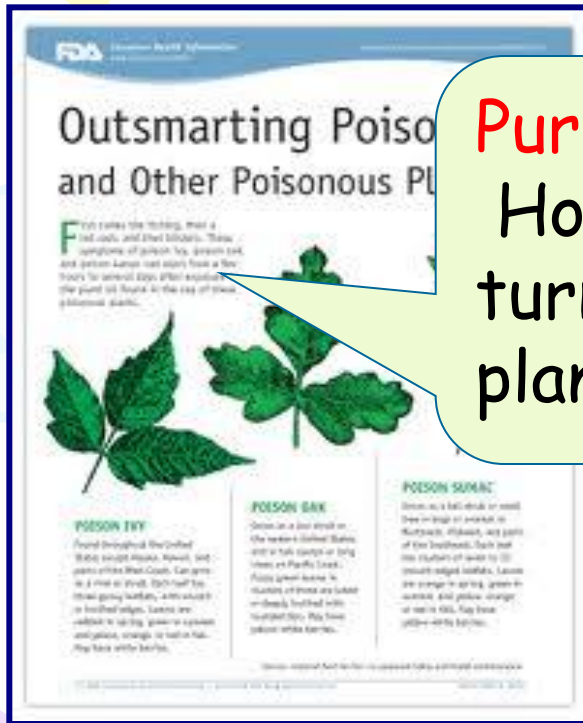
Guess based on the **picture** and **title**.

Pre-Reading: Set the purpose for Reading

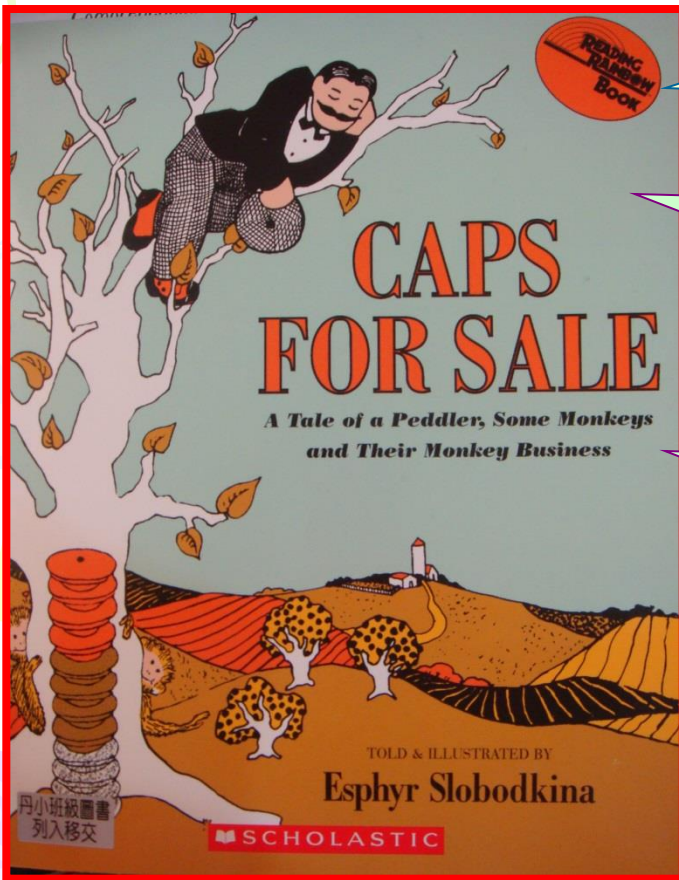


Purpose:
