intervention reading

- definition:

- (1) accelerating the development of children's literacy skills
- (2) progressing reading comprehension



Intervention reading

- · In Elliott elementary school
 - Students are leveled with their reading
 - 1st~4th: Horizon (lower and higher level)
 - 5th ~6th: Gateway (gather students all together)



Horizon (1st~4th)

- . teaching process:
 - sight words
 - phonemic awareness
 - reading the story
 - writing the worksheet

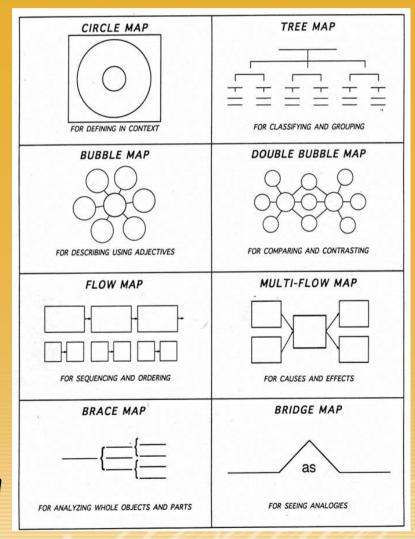
(6 students: 1 teacher)





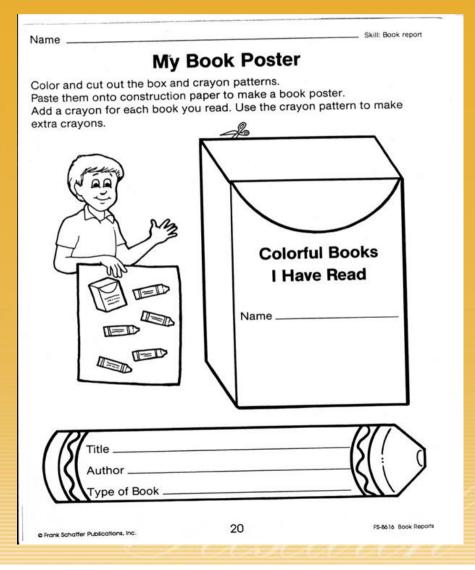
Application: Integrated intervention reading into story teaching

 - comprehensive writing



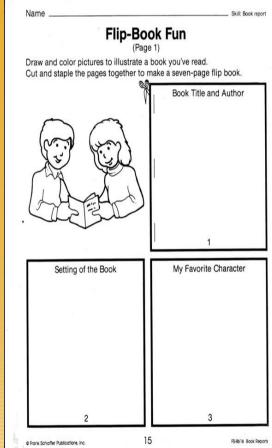


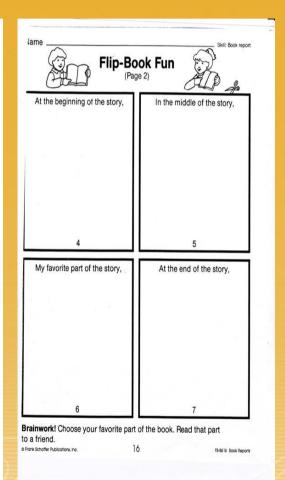

 - answers: be narrative and descriptive



Application:

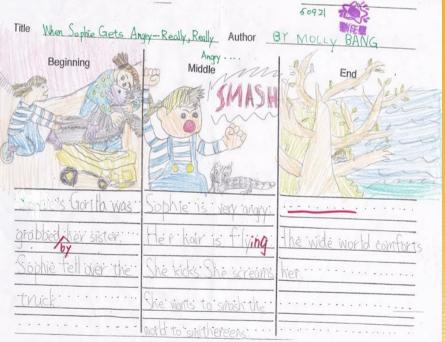
- "When Sophie gets angry really, really angry..."

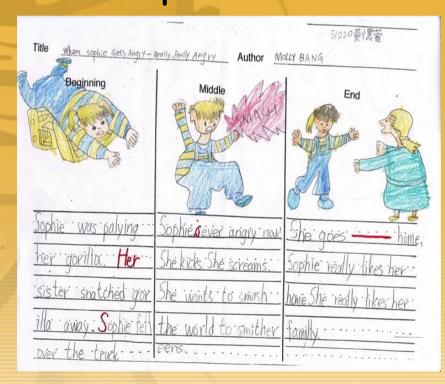


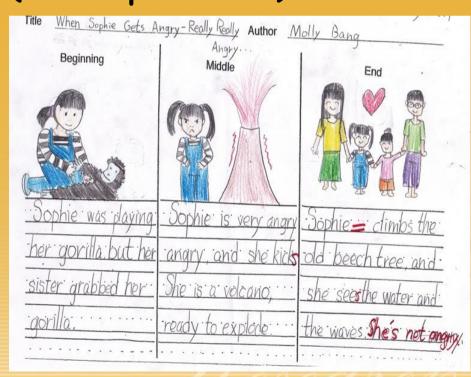
