Lesson Topic	My five senses	Grade Level	4
Teaching Material	PPT, YouTube, Lemon/Orange	Number of Ss	13

Lesson Objectives:

- ✓ Students will be able to know senses
- ✓ Students will learn more about the vocabulary in senses
- ✓ Students will be confident speaking around their peers

Target language:

- ✓ Eyes, ears, nose, tongue, hands, see, hear, smell, taste, touch

Target sentence:

- ✓ This is a lemon/ an orange. It is green/orange. Yes I have/No I haven't.
- ✓ I see with my eyes
- ✓ I hear with my ears
- ✓ I smell with my nose
- ✓ I taste with my tongue
- ✓ I touch with my hands

Teaching Procedures	Time
Warm-up: Prior knowledge ✓ Review body parts	2min
Hook: Show students a fruit and ask them what this is? What color is it? Have you eaten this fruit before? Did you like it or not?	3 min
Presentation: (short story about the use of the senses) ✓ Teacher will introduce the topic of the lesson based on the story. She will ask students to name the senses they know. ✓ Teacher will list all 5 senses and she will discuss the activities on each sense.	5min
(sense of hearing) ✓ Teacher will ask students to produce any sound. Ask how was that sound and which sense did they use? ✓ Teacher will ask students to close their eyes and teacher will play different audios. ✓ Students will have to listen carefully and identify the sound of each audio. ✓ Which body part do we use for the sense of hearing? Ears- I hear with my ears.	18min

<p>(sense of sight)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Teacher will show different pictures. Have students close their eyes and then remove one picture, ask them to open their eyes and ask them what the missing picture is? Continue the game, changing pictures. ✓ Which body part do we use for the sense of sight? Eyes- I see with my eyes. <p>(sense of smell)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Teacher will ask students to take off one shoe and smell it. Ask the whole class which body part do we use for the sense of smell? Teacher will ask students to name some of the things they can smell with their nose. Nose- I smell with my nose. <p>(sense of taste)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Show different pictures (chilies, candy, french fries) and ask students to match them with the different taste. ✓ Tongue- I taste with my tongue. <p>(sense of touch)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Students to touch different objects. (hair, table, hands, etc) ✓ Hand- I touch with my hands. 	
<p>Production:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Teacher will assess students understanding by asking them to do a worksheet on senses. (completing sentences) 	10min
<p>Wrap up:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Review sentences, pack up 	2min
