Recreation Name: Marine evolution game/ Algae tag

Materials Needed: N/A

Space Needed: Outdoor court or big/open indoor space

Rundown:

A. Marine evolution game-

1. Explain the rules for the game and how to play.
 - i. The objective is to evolve to a human.
 - ii. All students start as fish then evolve ->frogs->sharks->human.
 - iii. Demonstrate each action for the animals.
 - iv. Tell students that they have to keep doing the action for the stage of evolution that they're at.
 - v. Students have to approach other students. When they find a partner they will play paper, scissors, stone.
 - vi. The winner evolves to the next animal and the loser devolves to the previous stage or stays the same if they are a fish.
 - vii. Make sure to tell students that they can only play with a student once. They will need to find new people each round.
 - viii. The first student to evolve to a human wins.
 - ix. Ask students if they want to play again.

B. Algae tag

1. Explain the rules and how to play.
 - i. One person starts as algae
 - ii. Everyone else is a fish.
 - iii. All the students start at one end of the field.
 - iv. The objective is to run to the other side without being tagged by the algae.
 - v. Each time the algae touches a fish it becomes linked to the algae.
 - vi. The algae will grow each round as a chain.
 - vii. The last fish standing wins.
