

6. EXTERNAL EVALUATIONS

- This evaluation makes up 30% of the total evaluation score.
- It will affect the teacher's evaluation bonus.
- Observers will use the evaluation rubric found in Appendix E in the contract.
- Feedback will be given orally during the feedback session.
- NSTs will also receive written feedback at a later date.
- A score of 90 points or higher will receive the added benefit of one additional annual leave day to be used within the contract year.





