Participants will create a summer camp curriculum plan and enter that information into the Summer Camp Course Design Template form, paying attention to complete each part of the form.

Workshop Part 3: Fine-Tuning Summer Camp Course Designs (13:00-14:40)

In this part of the workshop, participants will include additional details in their camp courses as well as receive feedback on the current alignment between camp course particulars and the camp course design rubric.

Workshop Part 4: Presenting a Summer Camp Course for Review (15:00-15:45)

Participation Award: All participants in the summer course design workshop will receive a 7-11 store voucher worth 300NT.

Innovation Award: A restaurant voucher will be awarded to the school judged to have submitted the most innovative, practical, or creative course design.
