
##### 【Loudon Forestry Culture Tour】

Originally the **Luodong Timber Mill**, the site has been transformed into a cultural and ecological exhibition base that preserves the important historical legacy of Taiwan's forestry development. Centered on the logging, transportation, and processing operations of the Taipingshan forestry industry from the Japanese colonial era through the postwar period, the Luodong Forestry Culture Park is filled with the scent of cypress wood.

Japanese-style dormitories can be seen throughout the grounds, along with many well-preserved forestry heritage structures, including log storage ponds, steam locomotives, forest railway remains, old warehouses, and various operational facilities. These features

collectively showcase the 68-year history of forestry activities that began in 1921.

In those days, logging trains slowly traveled the roughly 37-kilometer route to Luodong. The black coal smoke billowing from afar stood as a symbol of the once-glorious era of Taiwan's forestry industry.

### 【The National Center for Traditional Arts-Yilan Park】

Located in Wujie Township, Yilan, the National Center for Traditional Arts is a cultural park dedicated to traditional Taiwanese architecture, craftsmanship, and folk culture. The park recreates early settlement scenes through its old-style streets, including the Wenchang Temple, traditional shop houses, and artisan workshops, offering visitors a rich and immersive Taiwanese cultural atmosphere.

## 【Park Highlights】

- Recreated Traditional Architectural Settlement:**  
Features Minnan-style courtyard houses, old streets, and ancestral halls that vividly present early Taiwanese life.
- Folk Performances and Cultural Shows:**  
Daily programs include the “Techno Third Prince,” glove puppetry, musical performances, and demonstrations of traditional folk arts.
- Resident Craftsmen:**  
Visitors can observe artisans up close as they create works such as indigo dyeing, woodcraft, paper umbrellas, dough figurines, and glass art.
- Shopping Street:**  
Filled with specialty shops, cultural-creative goods, and traditional snacks.

### Recommended activities:

- Craft Workshops:**  
Indigo dyeing, woodworking, pottery, dough figurines—create your own traditional Taiwanese craft.
- Traditional Children’s Games:**  
Spin tops, bamboo guns, pinball tables, and other nostalgic local games.
- Boat Ride on the Dongshan River:**  
Enjoy scenic views of the park and natural surroundings from the water.
- Cultural Guided Tours:**  
Gain deeper insight into Taiwanese craftsmanship and the stories behind traditional ways of life.
